WELCOME TO THE SILVER LINE EXTENSION

The Silver Line Extension brings the Metrorail system into Loudoun County and provides nearly 12 miles of new track extending northwest from Wiehle-Reston East Station. The extension provides a direct Metrorail connection to Washington Dulles International Airport and ends in Ashburn, Virginia. Traveling inbound, the Silver Line connects riders to Reston, Tysons, and Rosslyn before entering downtown DC and continuing out to the Downtown Largo Station in Maryland.

The extension includes six new Metrorail stations—Reston Town Center, Herndon, Innovation Center, Washington Dulles International Airport, Loudoun Gateway, and Ashburn—along with a new 90-acre Dulles rail maintenance yard where trains will be cleaned, serviced, and inspected.

Silver Line trains will ramp up to every 10 minutes during rush hour; every 12 minutes during midday, evening, and weekends; and every 15 minutes during late-night hours. **Enjoy Wi-Fi-connected, traffic-free access to work, home, shop, and play!**

Metro Access' is a shared-ride, door-to-door, paratransit service for people traveling within Metro's service area whose disability prevents them from using bus or rail. If you think you may need paratransit service, visit wmata.com/MetroAccess.

HOW DO I PAY?

Like other Metrorail lines, Silver Line fares are based on distance traveled and the time and day when traveling, with fares ranging from \$2 – \$6. Any one-way trips taken after 9:30 p.m. during the week and all weekend long are only \$2! To easily plan your trip and calculate your fare, visit wmata.com/TripPlanner.

SMARTRIP IS YOUR TICKET TO RIDE

A SmarTrip® card is how to pay for your fare at all Metrorail stations,



Metrobus routes, Metro parking garages and lots, and partner regional bus providers, including Fairfax Connector and Loudoun County Transit.

SmarTrip in Apple Wallet or Google Pay provides a convenient, contactless way to quickly purchase a transit card to pay for a trip on a train or bus, or for parking wherever SmarTrip is accepted. Adding SmarTrip to your mobile device lets you skip the fare vending machines in stations when you're in a hurry, and there's no need to carry cash. Manage purchases, tap, and go—all from your phone! FAIRFAX CONNECTOR

TONNECTOR Fairfax Connector provides bus service throughout Fairfax County and adjacent areas. All new Silver Line stations in Fairfax County are served by Fairfax Connector, with connections between new Silver Line stations and areas in Herndon, Reston, and beyond. LOUDOUN COUNTY TRANSIT

Loudoun County Transit will begin new and modified transit routes when Silver Line service begins. This service includes bus routes to and from the Ashburn, Loudoun Gateway, Innovation Center, and Reston Town Center Metrorail stations. All of the new Silver Line stations, except Washington Dulles International Airport, have convenient Kiss & Ride drop-off locations where cars can easily pull in to safely drop off or pick up riders.



🚳 BIKE & RIDE

All of the new Silver Line stations, except Washington Dulles International Airport, have bike racks and bike lockers. Innovation Center and Herndon stations also have bike parking in secure bike rooms. Metro welcomes bikes on trains at all times. RESTON TOWN CENTER

In the median of the Dulles Airport Access Highway/Dulles Toll Road just west of the Reston Parkway overpass

Reston Town Center is the first of the six new stations extending the Silver Line past Wiehle-Reston East.

Two Station Entrances: Pedestrian bridges available from both sides of the Dulles Airport Access Highway/Dulles Toll Road

Kiss & Ride: Available on both sides; no hourly parking in Kiss & Ride lot

Bicycles: 40 bike racks and 22 bike lockers in total, with future Capital Bikeshare stations planned

Parking: No commuter parking

This station will serve commuters traveling to Reston, Tysons, DC, and Maryland. It will also serve the nearby planned transit-oriented development.

Two Station Entrances: Pedestrian bridges available from both sides of the Dulles Airport Access Highway/Dulles Toll Road


Kiss & Ride: Available on both sides; no hourly parking in Kiss & Ride lot

In the median of Dulles Toll Road/Airport Access Highway near the intersection of Route 28

This station is near the Center for Innovative Technology, making travel to the technology hub more accessible for those visiting and working.

STATION FACILITIES


Two Station Entrances: Station entrances are located on both sides of the Dulles Toll Road from Innovation Avenue (north entrance) and Sunrise Valley Drive at Carta Way (south entrance)

Kiss & Ride: Available on both sides; no hourly parking in Kiss & Ride lot

Bicycles: 177 bike racks and 10 bike lockers with secure bike storage room available, along with 2 repair stations and a bottle-filling station

Parking: Parking for approximately 2,000 cars in a garage on the south side of the station; no reserved or multi-day parking; future EV charging stations planned

WASHINGTON DULLES INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT



44920 Saarinen Circle, Sterling, VA 20166

Adjacent to Parking Garage 1, opposite terminal

Located on airport property, Dulles Station connects the Metrorail system to Washington Dulles International Airport for the first time.

STATION FACILITIES

One Station Entrance: Accessible from the underground pedestrian tunnel, connecting the station to the baggage claim level of the main terminal and to the airport's adjacent Parking Garage 1

Kiss & Ride: No Kiss & Ride


Bicycles: No bike racks or bike lockers

What's Nearby: Washington Dulles International Airport is connected to the station via a climate-controlled pedestrian tunnel with moving walkways; Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum's Udvar-Hazy Center, rental cars, and hotels are also nearby

LOUDOUN GATEWAY



22505 Lockridge Road, Sterling, VA, 20166 Located in the median of the Dulles Greenway, just west of the intersection of Route 606

This station is located close to a low-rise industrial development near the Dulles North Transit Center. The station is expected to be a commuting hub.

STATION FACILITIES

Two Station Entrances: Two entrances on the north side lead to the pedestrian walkway crossing over Dulles Greenway into the station

Kiss & Ride: Available on east side (near parking garage) with ADA spaces and spots reserved for safety vehicles; lot has shuttle drop-off points but no hourly parking

Bicycles: 113 bike racks and 10 bike lockers in total

Parking: Parking for approximately 2,000 cars in one parking lot and one parking garage, both located on one side of the station; parking garage includes ADA spaces, EV charging spaces, and fuel-efficient spaces; Dulles North Transit Center has extra parking nearby for 750 cars



What's Nearby: Dulles North Transit Center Park & Ride Lot

ASHBURN



43655 Ashburn Metro Drive, Ashburn, VA 20147

Located in the median of the Dulles Greenway near the intersection of Route 772 (Ryan Road)

Ashburn Station is the new terminus station for the Silver Line. Located in Loudoun County, it serves Ashburn, Loudoun Station development, Moorefield Station development, Brambleton, and beyond.

STATION FACILITIES

Two Station Entrances: Pedestrian bridges available from both sides of the Dulles Greenway

Kiss & Ride: Available on both sides with ADA spaces and spots reserved for safety vehicles; Kiss & Ride lots have shuttle drop-off points but no hourly parking

Bicycles: 131 bike racks and 30 bike lockers in total

Parking: Parking for approximately 3,000 cars in a garage and Park & Ride, one on each side of the station, with ADA spaces, EV charging spaces, and fuel-efficient spaces
