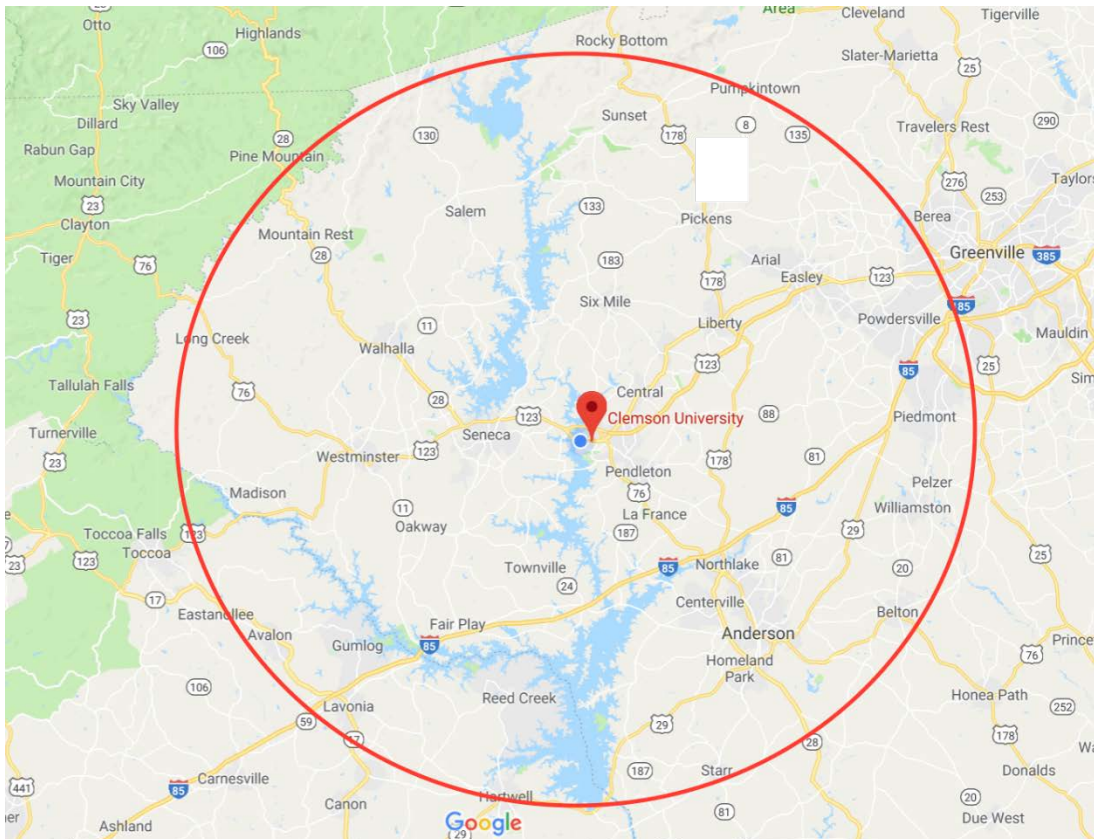
All CU coaches or sport-specific staff members who wish to serve in any capacity with a local sports club must first provide a completed Local Sports Club Information form to Compliance. Please note the following guidelines apply when working with a local sports club:

Organizing a Local Sports Club

- Local sports clubs must be established, on-going entities, and must engage in competitions. It is not permissible for a coach to form a club team solely to provide instruction to prospects and/or student-athletes.

Prospects and Student-Athletes Participating in Local Sports Clubs

- Any prospects participating in local sports clubs must legally reside within 50 miles of CU's campus (see map on form).
 - A prospect who legally resides more than 50 miles from CU may not participate in a local sports club, even if they sign a lease in the Clemson area for the time during which he or she participates with the club. The "legal residence" standard was not intended to apply to situations wherein a prospect moves to the locale to attend a collegiate institution. It was only intended to apply to situations wherein the prospect's permanent residence is within a 50-mile radius of campus (e.g. the prospect's family moves to the Clemson area, and they are no longer residents of their previous location). See January 7, 2007 NCAA official interpretation.
 - The 50-mile radius surrounding CU is approximately what the below illustration indicates. If you have questions about whether a particular address falls within the permissible radius, or any other questions regarding local sports club activity, please contact the Compliance Office.**
- In sports where they are permitted to participate on their collegiate coach's outside club team, CU student-athletes may not be provided any benefit that is not provided to other members of the club. This includes reduced membership fees, additional access to facilities, additional instruction time, etc.

Financial Policies

- Local sports clubs must be established and operated with private funds, separate from the CU athletics budget. The CU athletic department may not sponsor any local sports club that includes prospects. Examples of sponsorship would include reduced-price facility rentals, reimbursement of club-related expenses, or providing supplemental pay to club coaches.
- A local sports club which includes prospects may rent CU facilities, provided those facilities are open to rental by outside entities and provided the club pays the same rate those outside groups would be charged for use of the facilities.
- Publicity and fundraising activities for local sports clubs must be independent from CU’s athletics program and funds may not be commingled (i.e. money raised by the club may not be used by the athletic department and vice versa).

13.11.2.4 Local Sports Clubs. In sports other than basketball, an institution’s coach may be involved in any capacity (e.g., as a participant, administrator or in instructional or coaching activities) in the same sport for a local sports club or organization located in the institution’s home community, provided all prospective student-athletes participating in said activities are legal residents of the area (within a 50-mile radius of the institution). In all sports, an institution’s coach may be involved in any capacity (e.g., as a participant, administrator or in instructional or coaching activities) in a sport other than the coach’s sport for a local sports club or organization located in the institution’s home community, provided all prospective student-athletes participating in said activities are legal residents of the area (within a 50-mile radius of the institution). Further, in clubs or organizations involving multiple teams or multiple sports, the 50-mile radius is applicable only to the team with which the institution’s coach is involved; however, it is not permissible for the coach to assign a prospective student-athlete who lives outside the 50-mile area to another coach of the club. A coach also may be involved in activities with individuals who are not of a prospective student-athlete age, regardless of where such individuals reside. (In women’s volleyball and women’s sand volleyball, see Bylaws 13.1.7.12 and 13.1.7.13, respectively, for regulations relating to a coach’s involvement with a local sports club and the permissible number of evaluation days.) **[D]** *(Revised: 1/10/90, 1/16/93, 9/6/00, 4/25/02 effective 8/1/02, 5/11/05)*

13.11.2.4.1 Exception. The 50-mile radius restriction shall not apply to a prospective student-athlete who resides outside a 50-mile radius of the institution, provided the institution documents that the local sports club is the closest opportunity for the prospective student-athlete to participate in the sport. *(Adopted: 1/9/06 effective 8/1/06)*

13.11.2.4.2 Legal Resident. A prospective student-athlete who relocates to an area within a 50-mile radius of the institution on a temporary basis (e.g., to participate on a club team or attend an institution while maintaining a permanent residence outside the 50-mile radius) is not a legal resident of the area regardless of whether the prospective student-athlete meets legal standards of state or local residency for governmental purposes. *(Adopted: 9/18/07)*

13.11.2.4.3 Institutional Sponsorship of Local Sports Club. Neither an institution’s athletics department nor an institution’s athletics booster group may sponsor a local sports club that includes prospective student-athletes. It is permissible for a department of the institution that operates independent of the athletics department (e.g., physical education department, recreation department) to sponsor a local sports club that includes prospective student-athletes, provided no athletics department staff member is involved with the club team. **[D]** *(Adopted: 1/16/93, Revised: 1/11/94)*
